6. **Discussion after “presentation of future strategy”**
Discussion on the topics of the presentation of Sandro Pertile in the morning and adding possible additions like:
 - Coaches education
 - Children and Youth Competitions are needed
 - Biggest problem for NSAs to bring Youth up to JWSC and WC
 - sharing knowledge between small and big nations

SLO: 2005 were 20 girls in the COC, that's now the number for women at skiflying, last 20 years very good development. 10% NH in WC, very important for the juniors. Next Gen WC in the morning!

AUT: Development is a very important issue as well

 - FIS Youth competitions – numbers are in the presentation

SUI: Youth Cup very important series between national competition and FIS-Cup. FIS Youth Cup in NC in AUT, CZE, but no competitions for SJ (??!!)

Grave: reports about the Youth Cup NC and the difference to SJ, competitions are very important for the development of young athletes.

Neumayer: WC-COC-Youth, specifically for cross-country important. GER is thinking about opening the “Deutschland Pokal” for international participants.

Haim: FESA Cup is also open for more nations nowadays, he shows COC-Development on PPT. General level is good, important to keep for the next 10 years

Renata: Motivation for U21 could be a special ranking within COC results

 - FIS Cup
 - Numbers are in presentation
 - Limit of age, 23 and younger could be a n idea
 - USA:** were two times in FIS-Cup, its hard to decide when is the right time for bringing the young athletes overseas because of costs. Competitions are still important!
 - Renata** asks USA if there are more kids in ski jumping after WC and JWM, yes there are quite a lot of new kids and 60-70% of girls of that.
 - Haim:** Lake Placid has very good venues, lots of steps are done
 - Renata:** Shows sheet of ICOC: POL only Men, SLO has the most Women, SUI has more and more girls, sill only juniors.
 - JWSC Lake Placid (USA)
 - Haim:** statistics see presentation
 - Schödler:** shows presentation, see attached: Thanks and Congrats to OC, most important competition for Juniors, Social Media gets more important – Toni on site did perfect job, also livestream and on Tiktok, JWC was present! Schedule changes because of the weather were positive (good Jury and OC work), Transportation could have been organized better. Hall of Fame and statistic see on sheet in presentation. 2026 Trondheim: NC, SJ, CC
 - Blank:** education program for JWC?
 - There is a very tight schedule at JWSC, better for Next Gen WC/COC
 - Women's Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined
