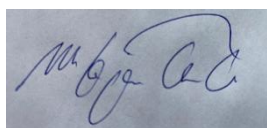

Chairman, Andreas Bauer reports on the meeting of 24.09.2025.

- Thanks to FIS for creating new position of Mathias Hafele as Equipment Specialist
- Positive development from “rejuvenated” team
- Equipment workshops carried out by Hafele to all teams during the spring and early summer
- All FIS controllers – long working days – huge workload
- Limitation of suit numbers, increased numbers of controllers present onsite
- Teams are satisfied with clear procedures
- Start control – better behaviour at start
- women’s injuries this summer
- Predazzo injuries – high flying curve, high altitude, tail wind, equipment set up, suit size same, only stricter execution of rules
- Better and closer coordination with NC
- Gloves – new rules from 2026/27 season concerning wrist strap – not allowed
- technical approval – 1 suit per athlete per weekend, 2 suits per athlete at OWG, only 1 recheck per nation allowed, national group as a separate nation at TA
- start control procedures have been updated, collar of the suit must be in full contact with the body
- suit fabric – only FIS registered producers allowed
- FIS Media and Marketing approval of suits – new procedure
- Updated rules for underwear
- video surveillance allowed, also for DSQ
- sleeve shortened to -5 cm maximum
- permeability difference between various parts of the suit increased to 20 litres
- women suit – crotch and leg length -2 cm; 2-5 cm from armpit to knee – valid from Klingenthal
- women – 1 suit for everyone allowed in Klingenthal
- sanctions yellow/red cards system (Sandro Pertile)
- working group on suits – reported by Lasse Ottesen (measurements, suits, materials, etc.)
- BMI – report by Veronica Bressone, contribution by Piotr Krężałek
- Change of procedure - Female and male doctors available at 3D body scans for the respective gender
