#### 6. FIRST draft of the FIS TD list 2021/2022 – G. Kadykov

Mr. Kadykov presented long distance races TD list. Visma SkiClassics races will have less TD-s working during the season to have more consistent decision trough the season. Worldloppet, Euroloppet and other events TD-s were discussed with local

coordinator and mostly TD-s were selected from organizing country, to avoid traveling in covid situation.

# 7. Popular long distance races Season 2020 2021

7.1 Short report of Juha Viljamaa – WL President

Participation has dropped dramatically in last two seasons:

2019 - 123 000

2020 - 74 000 (9 000 virtual racers)

2021 - 31 000 (15 000 virtual racers)

7800 new unique participants

1733 skiers participated multiple races

122 skiers skied 7 or more races

80% virtual racers did races on skies

Only 26% of participant are women.

# 7.2 Visma Ski Classics – Short Report CEO David Nilsson

Original plan was 12 races – 8 races were held in season 2020/2021 Number of participating women is rising every year – this season it was 40% Next season plan is to have 12 Pro Tour weekends and 40 races are joined Challenger program.

VSC has hired Anton Karlsson (former athlete) working as Sport Director. VSC wanna empower the TD role, to combine TD and RD tasks. Pierre Mignerey and Vegard Ulvang: TD-s must follow the ICR and control that race is organized according to the rules, they must be independent, this two positions can't be mixed.

#### 8. F.I.S. Point at Popular races

- 8.1 Only for races over 30 Km
- 8.2 One competition per EVENT
- 8.3 Organizer must tell FIS and NSA which is the main race

Proposal: fis penalty can be calculated in all races where following criterias are full filled: minimum 30 km distance and 5 fis licensed athletes finishing the race.

### 9. Temperature Limit of -25° at popular races – Tommy Hoglund

Discussion to lower existing -25 to -20 degrees in popular races.

Proposal: Tommy Höglund proposed to not make any quick decision, we need to analyze it.

Decision: Working group will be created and after deeper analyze proposal will be presented in Autumn Zürich meeting. Working group members: Tommy Höglund (Chairman), Anton Karlsson (athlete), Enzo Macor (race organizer), Georgy Kadykov, one member will be selected from FIS medical committee.

#### 10. Other matter arising

Georgy Kadykov presented following rule corrections:

NEW 387.5 In competition with Block (wave) start, early start infraction should be sanctioned by time penalty equal to the time gained (actual wave start time minus actual offender's start time) + 30 minutes minimum penalty.

381.7 must be removed – FIS Marathon cup doesn't exist anymore.
