Martins Niklass goes through the applications received.

First application came from NOR NSA. Asgeir Moberg presents the new venue and OC (see attachment ***TelemarksVeka World Cup 2022_compressed***) and OC. Martins Niklass refers about a successful inspection he has already made. The event is scheduled in the end of FIS calendar season 2021 but would be valid for the 2022 FIS Rollerski World Cup calendar and overall standings.

Second application came from EST NSA for the same event organized in 2021. Pavel Jestkov (RUS) proposes to have a short sprint both in NOR and EST.

Third application came from LAT NSA which requests both the WC stage and the JWSC. Dates have to be confirmed.

Fourth application will come from ITA NSA. Anna Rosa explains that dates can be set in the first or second weekend of September and that location and formats have still to be defined.

Martins Niklass explains that in order to include the NOR stage we need to make a decision on the following:

For the 1st stage of FIS Rollerski World Cup 2022 in Norway, Midt-Telemark 24-26.06.2022 age category restrictions for Junior categories will apply according FIS calendar season 2022/2023 (year of birth 2003-2007).
