### • FIS Youth competitions

It was not possible to hold youth competitions in summer time. The first event was in Hinterzarten/GER in the beginning of October under very strict rules. These OPA Games for Youth I for women and men had to be limited to a certain number of athletes and only four nations were attending.

All other competitions scheduled were cancelled.

#### • FIS Cup


The organisation of FIS Cups was possible in the winter season where 12 competitions were held. This is not far from our long term average. The numbers of participation (Nations and Athletes) were lower than in the previous seasons.

# • JWSC Lahti (FIN)

We have to be very thankful to the Finnish Ski Association for hosting the JWSC under the strict regime of the pandemic. The program was shortened and it was necessary to skip the Mixed Team in SJ and the Team in NC. Looking at the numbers of Athletes and Nations it is necessary to analyse the development of participation in our JWSC.

### • Women's Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined

Also the women's competitions suffered under the pandemic. As we see in the table we lost a lot of events in all levels compared to the average numbers of the last seasons. All NSA's have to work hard on a better calender for womens SJ to get a much better foundation of athletes for the World Cup. We have to be aware of the fact that developing female youth ski jumpers is a process which needs to be structured in certain steps or levels. Sizes of hills or difficulty of competitions are the measures in this field and it would be a huge mistake to forget about the women jumpers in this medium range!
