INTERNATIONAL SKI FEDERATION Sub-Committee Alpine Technical Delegates

1. Welcome and Opening of the Meeting

The Chairman opened the Meeting and welcomed all Sub-Committee members to this 3rd ONLINE meeting and regretted that he could not meet personally with them. He noted that despite the difficulties encountered with the many restrictions during the winter it was a very good season.

2. Members Present

Janez Flerè called the Roll (see on page 14)

3. Approval of the Agenda

The Agenda, without comments or remarks, was unanimously approved.

4. Approval of the Minutes of the ONLINE Meeting held on 28.09.2020

The Minutes of the previous Meeting, without comments or remarks, were unanimously approved.

5. Reports

5.1 Chairman

The Chairman was delighted to see all present and well. The start of the 2020/21 season was full of hope but was discovered to be most difficult. He did not believe that the virus would impact so hard on the 2020/21 season. Many found solutions in a most difficult season and he was most grateful for the commitment demonstrated by all. Some 2841 races were carried out with 47% of planned races cancelled (towards 68% the season before). The Chairman noted the high motivation of NSAs to run races and how they adapted to demands.

TDs assigned from own a nation was a good idea in helping to solve many travel restrictions and reacted to the demands of the OC's budgets. Some Race Directors had to step up to TD duties for a number of races. It may be that some OC's overused the possibility to replace TDs due to travel concerns however all worked very well in the end.

Adaptation of the calendar planning month by month enabled better solutions to restrictions brought about by the virus, still it was a difficult season and we can be very proud of yourselves. The Chairman personally thanked the Commissioners for their flexibility and super collaborations.

The Chairman informed the members of his intended resignation as he will be taking up the appointment as Chair of the World Cup Sub-Committee. He was most grateful for the support of the Sub-Committee members who, as a group have developed the mutual understanding of the TD role. Their reputation within the community as a whole is extremely high and reflects on the hard work by all Sub-Committee members.

He gave special thanks to Tatjana Luessy, Janez Fleré and Daniel Défago for their long term support.

Finally the Chairman asked all for a Minutes Silence in order to remember colleagues who passed away during the previous year: Charles Conrad (FRA), the former TD Sub-Committee's chairmen Toni Kaegi (SUI) and Stig Ove Gustavsson (SWE) and Darrell Mac Lachlan (CAN).

5.2 FIS Office

Janez Fleré thanked the Chairman for his very complete report. He thanked all the Commissioners for the decisions taken last year which were a great success. He was waiting for last minute changes before approaching the Commissioners nearer to events for TD assignments forwarded to all TDs. Likewise there were no Over Quota's nor problems with the Special Quota's. The FIS Covid 19 Prevention Risk Plan under the coordination and the support of Dimitrije Lazarovki was a great help during the entire winter season.

Finally he thanked the Chairman Walter Vogel on the Sub-Committee's behalf for his work and guidance over the many years together.

Markus Malsiner (ITA) expressed grateful thanks to the Chairman on behalf of all Commissioners. He noted that during the past months the ability to assign TDs brought in much flexibility and made for easy management and strongly supports such practice in the future. The way assignments were regulated during the Covid period made life easier however he requests that there should be a return to the original way of TD assignments.

The Chairman noted this critical point and wishes to look to the future and consider a way forward; he asked all to wait for the Autumn meeting in order to evaluate the situation then.

Peter Krogoll (GER) noted that the Sub-Committee need to be aware of OC's and own nation TDs and support the arguments for flexibility however he is extremely concerned about TD education, the TD Update, live online. This is not the way forward as there are concerns that education is not getting across. He wishes to return to group education soonest noting that ski jumping uses some inviting methods that should be considered.

The Chairman remarked that the "flexible" system of TD assignments is an exception to the normal manner of business and that where possible International TDs should always be used and notes that as soon as there is an open door to use local, national TDs then conflicts arise.

6. Reports from TD courses 2021 (Northern Hemisphere)

Michihiko Nakamura (JPN): Used the provided Update material and carried out tests to ensure education taken on. 3 x Candidates passed exams and first female TD in Asia confirmed. Social media was used to exchange Info and to provide advice.

<u>Hans Peter Pilz (AUT):</u> Education online was difficult. With some 60 TDs three groups were designated and many discussed the impact of Covid and how to react to it. There were many questions on this matter.

Anne Chantal Pigelet (FRA): Given the circumstances a good Update with some 50% of TDs present. There were 5-10 minute presentations on impact of restrictions to own person. Would prefer not to educate online however pleased that one Para TD achieved the TD exam.

Rolle Johansson (NOR): Also held an online meeting; there was one positive point to this method all were able to attend. Only a few present actually engaged in

discussions and the whole was time consuming. Looks forward to physical/on-site meetings again.

<u>Doug Campbell (CAN):</u> Along with USA had a good online TD Update. Used the week to make into smaller groups in order to discuss questions. There are some good points to this format due to the great travel distances in the region.

<u>Paul Van Slyke (USA):</u> Successful meeting with some 150 attending. This type of format useful however it requires teamwork and planning. In general a successful season. Wishes to thank Janez Fleré for his support throughout. Much effort required in order to ensure candidates managed exam.

<u>Jana Palovicova (SVK):</u> A good Update however would prefer onsite Update as much was missed by some TDs and many questions were not answered.

<u>Franz Hofer (SUI):</u> Within the meeting those present were split into groups but plan to meet together for future Updates.

<u>Peter Krogoll (GER):</u> An interesting meeting however prefer to meet together in order to ensure wide ranging education.

Here came a request from Janez Fleré to all Commissioners for material suitable for the coming Update.

<u>David Mansfield (GBR):</u> Using the material presented split those present into 10 groups with homework previously sent out in order that persons could study material before coming together. Would prefer to return to on-site meetings; interesting online meeting did not encourage more attendance.

<u>Matjaz Kranjc (SLO):</u> There were 12 nations attending, split into two meetings, each very successful. Currently looking for funds to provide group with ICR/TD booklets.

<u>Markus Malsiner (ITA):</u> All online but split into two groups. In future wishes to be able to return to on-site, face to face meetings.

<u>Enrique Diaz (ESP):</u> Supports future face to face meetings. The Group was able to exchange TDs and retain the international exchange system.

<u>Simon Wi Rutene (NZL):</u> Difficult times and very restricted at home. Plan on a normal Update hoping to open up skiing shortly. Some competitions at national level took place. Will preview coming Update and report back. Look forward to the time when a normal Update can take place.

<u>Alexej Orlov (RUS):</u> International and national TD Update online, there were two candidates and hope that these are ready as TDs for the coming season.

13. Miscellaneous

13.1 TD Assignments season 2021/22 (ICR art. 602.2.4)

The Chairman noted that it was extremely useful to hear the feedback from Commissioners and recalls the remarks from previous points:

Markus Malsiner (ITA) wished to publicly thank Dimitrije. Lazarovski (FIS) for his support throughout the difficult season.

Rolle Johansson (NOR): When using national TDs there were many changes and the reason for this was that local TDs used working days in order to gain free time and it became difficult to find a TD. He hoped most strongly that a return to the normal situation would be possible for the coming season and noted that some of his group TDs were unable to be assigned in the previous season.

David Mansfield (GBR) was extremely keen to return to International TDs and noted that wider experience was being missed by his TDs,

Franz Hofer (SUI) also hoped to return to the normal form of TD assignment quickly.

The Chairman asked whether there were any concerns with the use of local Juries/OCs/ TDs?

Markus Malsiner (ITA) reaffirmed previous remarks and noted that TDs should experience other OCs and Juries as part of their continuous training.

The Chairman asked whether one could continue with the month by month assignment system. Janez Fleré answered that this was possible but would require a standardised protocol and Calendar information.

Peter Krogoll (GER) noted that there was an advantage to month by month assignments however it was also good to be able to plan the whole season.

Other Issues

<u>Peter Krogoll (GER)</u> remarked that the FIS Council had discussed the matter of Ski Cross moving to Alpine and had briefly discussed the possibility of Ski Cross TDs becoming Alpine TDs. The question of how to integrate SC TDs as certain aspects of SC racing only appeared in that event. He asked whether there had been any discussions in the Alpine TD as to whether SC TDs could in fact be integrated.

<u>The Chairman</u> noted that so far no clear answers had appeared after discussions.

<u>Janez Fleré</u> remarked that according to current Council Minutes the SC TDs were still to stay with their own group. Annual Updates together could be carried out is so wished however no alpine licence would be issued is SC TDs do not attend. The Alpine Committee will receive their first report into this matter at their coming meeting.

There are still differing opinions on how to integrate SC Officials and TDs with Alpine with regards to Training/Update and Licencing.

The Chairman hoped that the next Meeting would be on site in Zürich, 28th September to 2nd October 2021

He again thanked all Commissioners for their superb support throughout his chairmanship.
