



#### **6.4 Equipment and Development**

Bertil Palsrud

Chairman Bertil Palsrud reports on the meeting held on 9.10.2023

- 3D scan for basis body measurements has been confirmed
- Further steps towards digitalisation of the control procedure will be continued to eventually arrive at suit scans
- Procedure description together with athlete consent form have been prepared by FIS staff and are available from FIS website
- Crotch control at start
  - +3 cm have been confirmed for men
  - change to 0 cm has been approved for women
- Measurement of torso / upper part of the body with the maximum tolerance of +6 cm has been introduced, measurement procedure will be specified in the guidelines
- The controllers will strictly execute crotch and leg cut in winter season
- Ski weight – Fischer has introduced scientific data to reduce the weight of the skis – the subcommittee shall work out new rules by spring meeting
- Ski stopper – after further discussion, including athletes, the use of ski stopper will not yet be mandatory, but recommended, the subcommittee will further work on the implementation of ski stopper as soon as possible after further specifications and test in winter season (international groups of fore-runners commissioned to test)
- Confirmation body scans will be taken for WC athletes at the beginning of winter season
- Ski wedge and boot sole height change from 70 mm to 50 mm has been confirmed

#### **Remarks**

Few questions were submitted by representative of NOR, CAN, Athletes' representative, SLO, GER, NED, ITA. POL

#### **Main answers/comments:**

##### **Tolerance 0 for Women athletes for crotch measurement**

Request for adjustment of 0 tolerance for crotch was based on the result of scientific research presented during spring meetings, that lower crotch makes turn-over time at the table almost too quick and this results in further acceleration in the last flight phase; from the very beginning this was meant

as a test and FIS was ready to go back on their decision if required; unfortunately new body scans were only made after the rule was introduced; after feedback from athletes and coaches (including coaches' meeting held during GP in Szczyrk) provided argumentation – less stability after take-off as well as problems with suit making for some athletes, it was decided that FIS will propose going back to 0 cm for women for winter season 2023/24

#### **Other remarks**

- thanks to FIS staff for summer Grand Prix series
- European Games in Zakopane
  - o best promotion of summer jumping in the last 5-10 years, only comparable to beginnings of GP series
  - o Good public in Zakopane big hill men event
  - o Good participation in the Games
- GP Courchevel and Szczyrk, no top athletes present, low participation especially on the girls 'side
- maybe teams have other concept, maybe we should give up on the summer events in general; on the other hand we have the Olympic quota issue and need to think about that as well
- I-COC / COC Lake Placid – weak point on the calendar, women event cancelled due to low number of entries
- FIS Cup Villach – only 6 nations entered (5 Alpen Cup nations plus only KAZ from outside of those), more nations should be encouraged to participate
- National championships taking place next weekend in many countries, we should not have any FIS events organised then (FIS Cup Rasnov – replacement for Ljubno, cancelled earlier on in the season due to floods that destroyed the hill)

#### **Other remarks from GER, NOR, SLO, Athletes' representative, POL**

- Organisers are struggling with sponsors because the big names are not present on-site during GP events
- We need to focus on the product attractiveness in general to increase number of public present on site
- COC Lake Placid – only 6 nations in the result list, adjustment of rule is needed

#### **1.2 Appointment of the I-COCJ-W-events**

1.2.1 The Sub-Committee for Calendar Planning examines:

- the suitability of the hill in question for I-COCJ-W-competitions by means of the valid hill certificate;
- the accommodation capacity and the spectator appeal of the competition site;
- the standard of the race organization.

### **WC Rules Women**

#### **4.9. World Cup Ski Flying Women**

The WCJ-events in Ski Flying must be carried out according to the World Cup rules for Ski Jumping as well as according to ICR art. 454.

For World Cup Ski Flying, only the top 15 ranked competitors of the current World Cup overall standings, and a maximum of five competitors who receive the starting right, are allowed to start.

Athlete must have eighteenth date of birth by the first official training day.

Maximum five athletes, who are top 15 of RAW-AIR standing after the WC in Trondheim on March 13 (Wednesday) 2024.

### **UNANIMOUSLY ACCEPTED BY THE COMMITTEE**

Clas Brede Brathen asked for introduction of Wild Card.

Horst Tielmann commented that the current rule does cover the exceptional cases and no exceptions shall be made, or in general as few as possible.

#### **Data Service during Inter-Continental Cup Women**

- A. when held together with COC Men – COC level
- B. when held together with FIS Cup Men – FIS Cup level

#### **Exception for WC competitions during Nordic events**

Some WC competitions during Nordic events, like Oslo, will be scheduled without trial round due to tight event programme.

Reasons - programme / TV transmission times / onsite - spectators etc.

### **UNANIMOUSLY ACCEPTED BY THE COMMITTEE**

With the comment from Clas Brede Brathen that it applies to both men and women, and not women only.

#### **Criteria for Youth Olympic Games**

#### **C.2. ADDITIONAL IF REQUIREMENTS**

Athletes must have also participated in FIS level or Continental Cup competitions during YOG qualification period from 1 July 2022 to 17 December 2023.

Inter-Continental Cup is FIS level series and the participation of I-COC W from 1 July 2023 to 17 December 2023 is valid for YOG 2024.

# COC general review

- Absolutely good and engaged cooperation with all teams and coaches.
- At all stations valuable cooperation with the OC's and jury teams which enabled us to have fair and high level competitions.
- New rulebooks and guidelines has to be spread inside NSAs. It is very surprising when the documents and rulebooks are not known on site.
- My thanks go to all FIS colleagues for the valuable exchange, to Ewoxx for the fast evaluation and the result service and to the FIS Staff in Oberhofen for the professional support. A big thank you and compliment goes to Madeline.

# COC Factsheet

- we were able to hold all 9 planned competitions in Oslo (NOR), Stams (AUT), Klingenthal (GER) and Lake Placid (USA) over the summer 2023.
- In the COC overall ranking Pius PASCHKE (GER), Clemens LAITNER (AUT) and Maximilian STEINER (AUT) occupy the top 3 of the summer ranking.
- Again we could experience very good athlete performances at all events.
- With some astonishment and disappointment we have to accept the partly missing interest in COC competitions. Less than an average of 10 nations participated in the summer COCs. A clear alarm sign Here can be discussed with pleasure, also in favor of our organizers.  
On the other hand, a thank you to all the teams and NSA's, that actively contributed to the success of the competitions.
- At the COC final in Lake Placid, only 7 nations were present for the final entry. Here I was glad about the 21 days before the competition procedure discussed in spring.

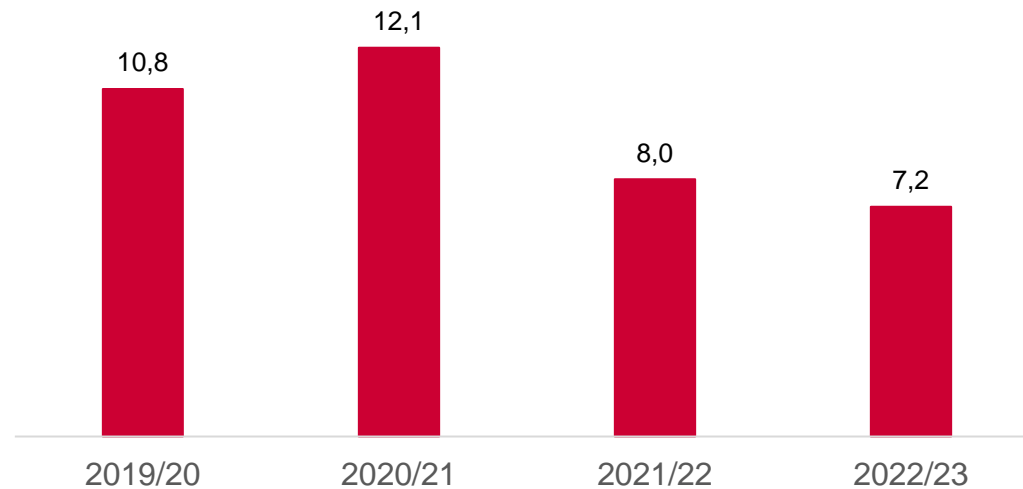

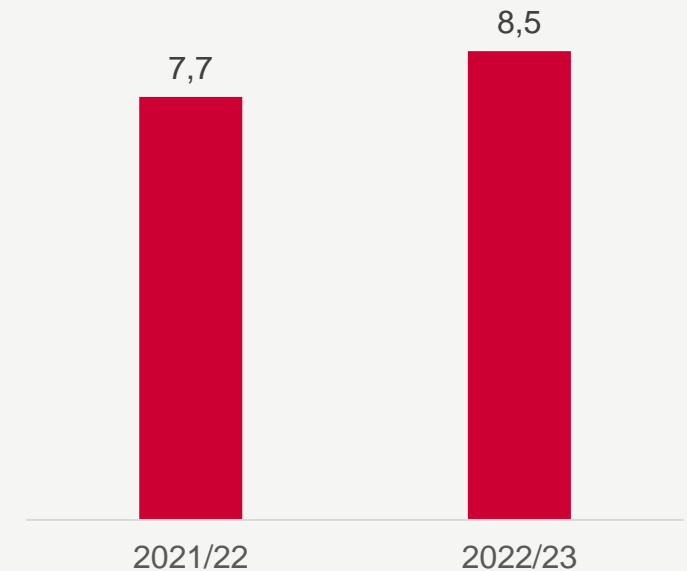

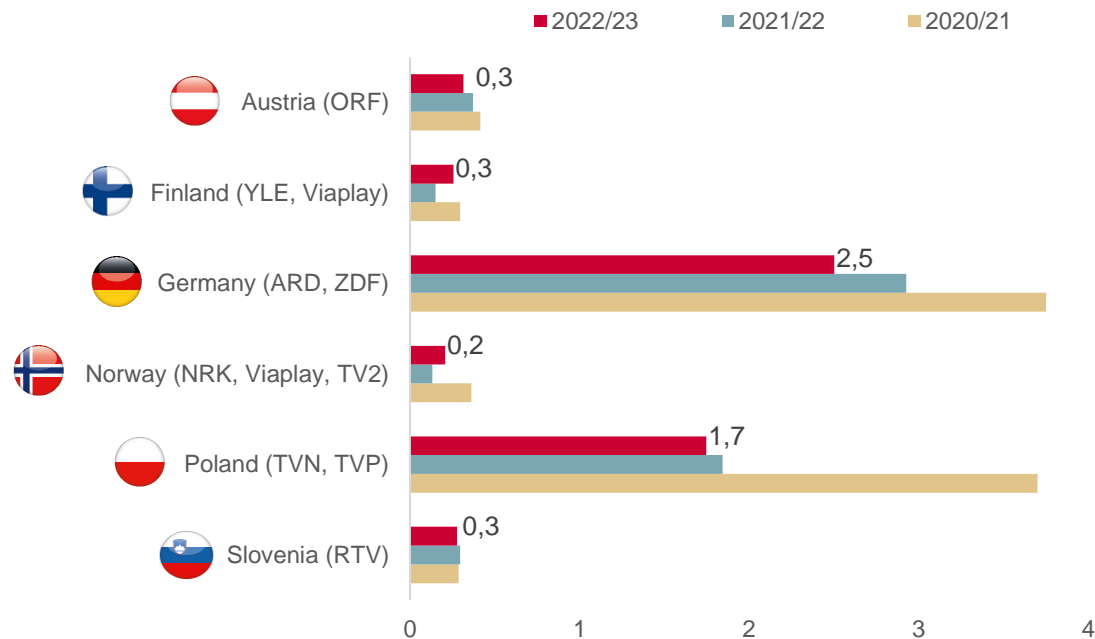

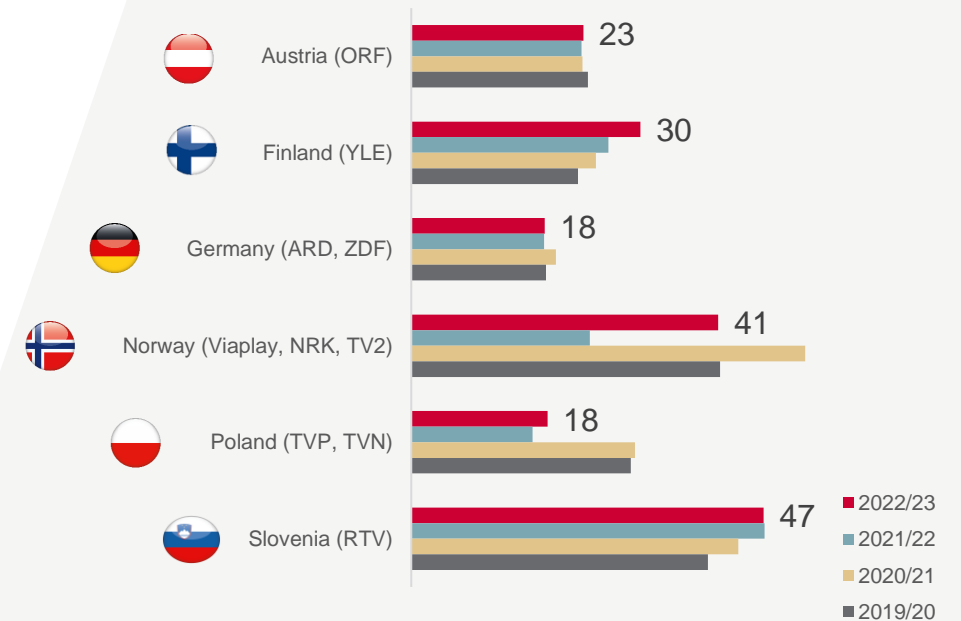
## Average Audience of main transmissions per Country

(in %)



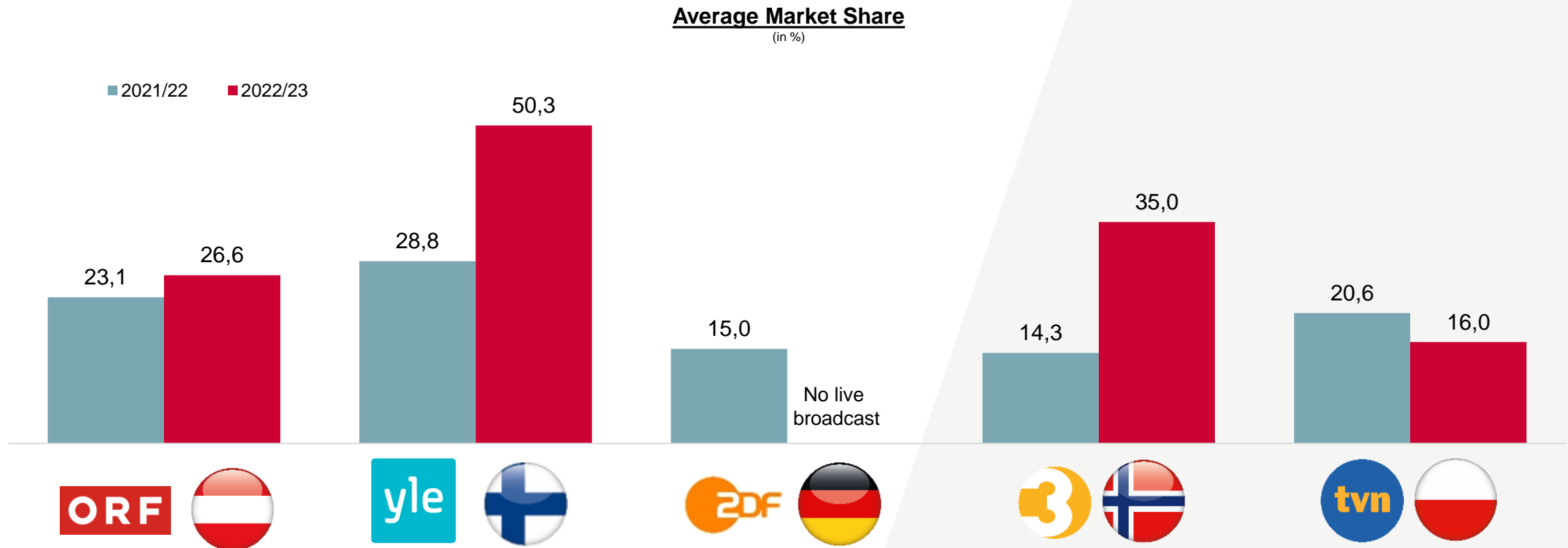

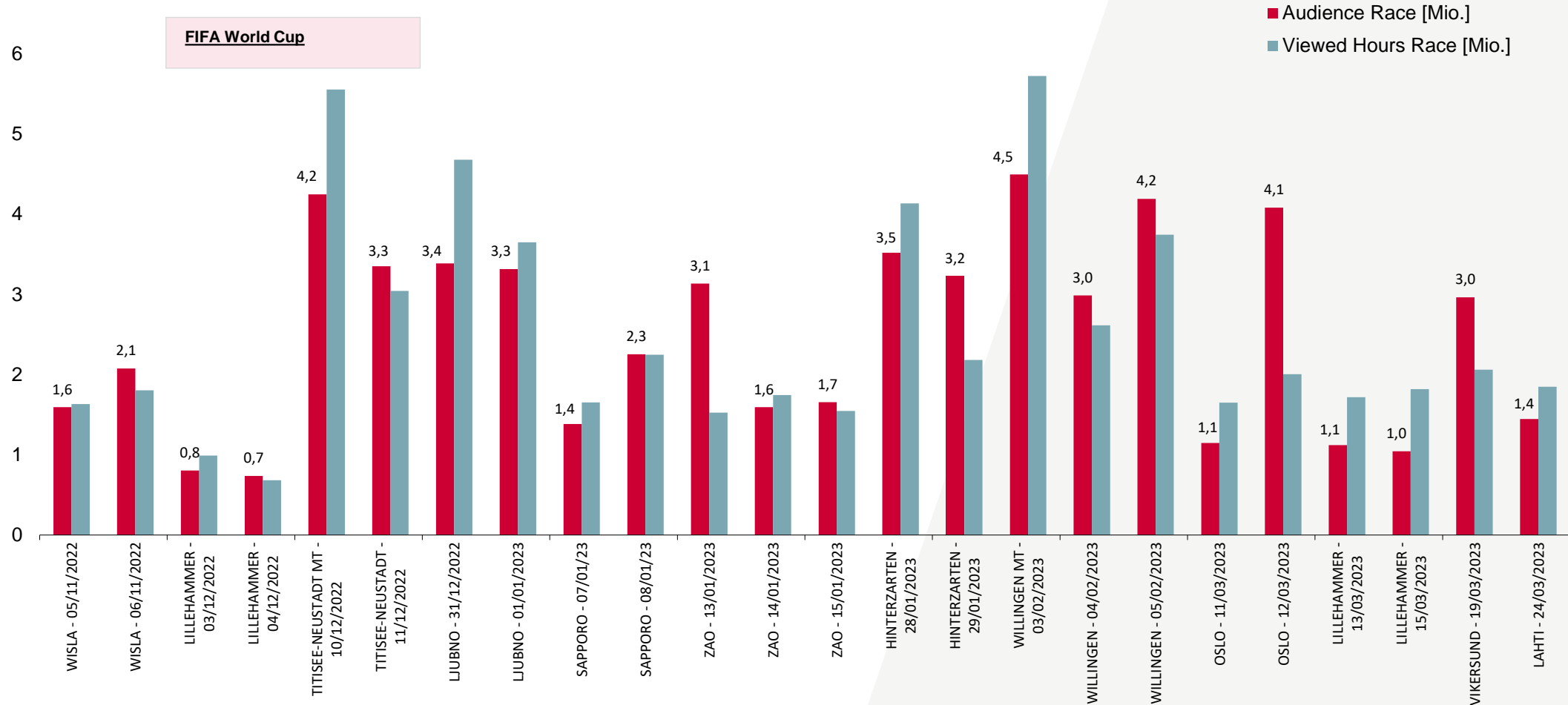

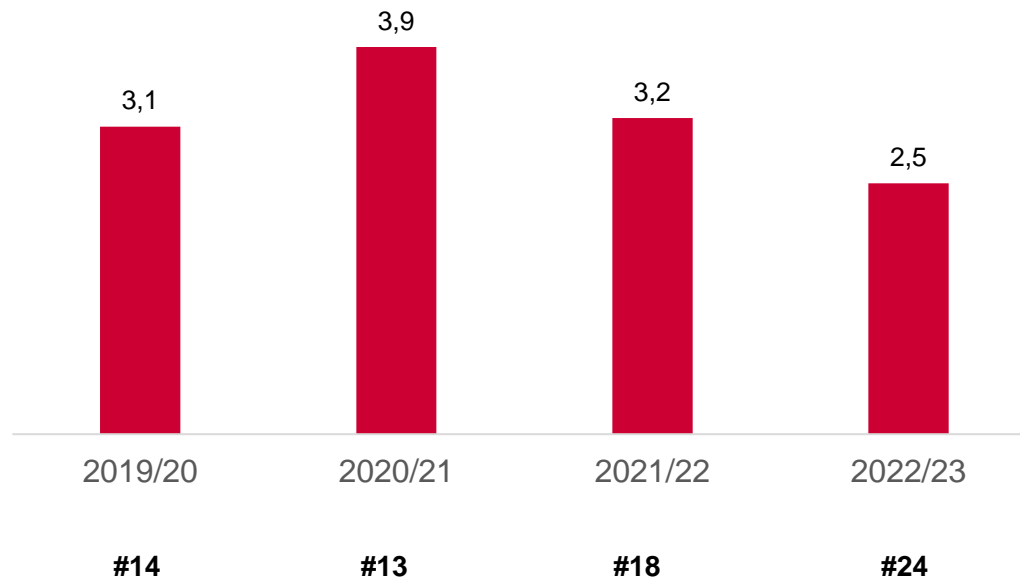

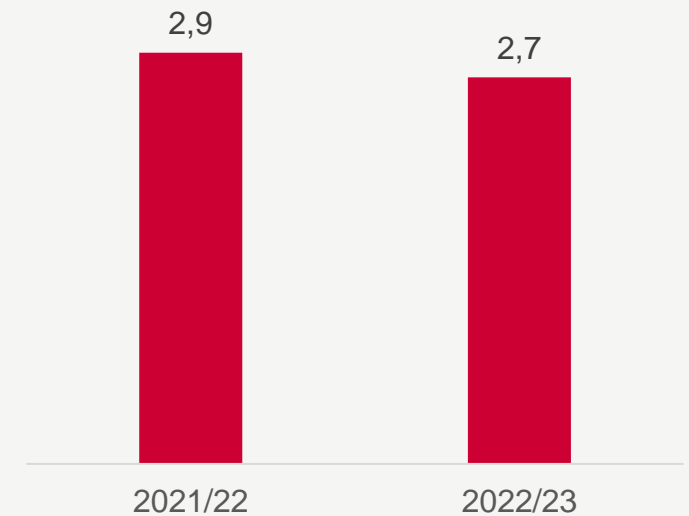

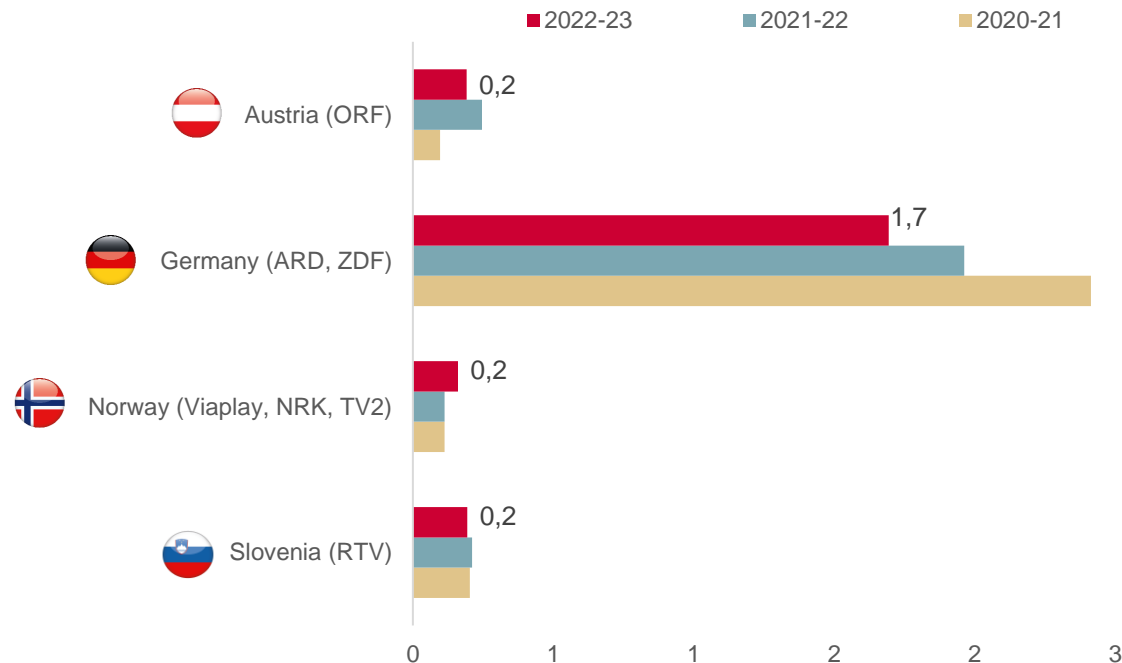

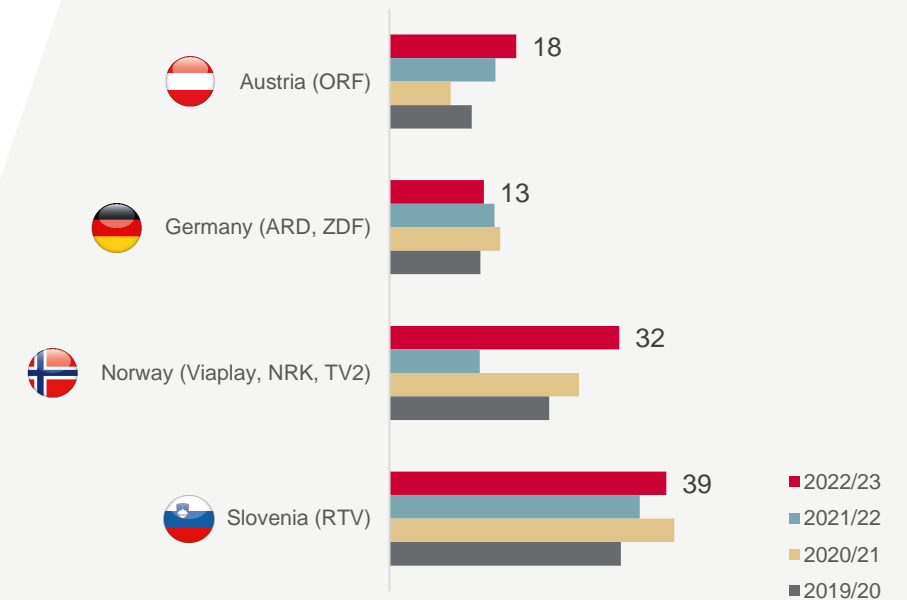
## Average Audience of main transmissions per Country

- In calendar we had 9 competitions but in Ljubno (2) and Lake Placid (3) were cancelled
  - ❖ Competitions in Ljubno (SLO) were cancelled due floods and heavy rain, causing damages on the jumping hills. Together with Hubert Mathis we had a serval calls with Slovenian NSA. We were looking for a solution to find another organizer, but accommodation turned out to be a problem. In such a short time we were unable to provide accommodation in Kranj and the surrounding area.
  - ❖ Competitions in Lake Placid (USA) had to be cancel due the low numner of entries. We had only entries from three countries (KAZ, NOR, USA). We postponed the deadline twice with Pre-entries, hoping that at least two additional countries would register, according to the regulations, to obtain ICOC status. The organizers did everything they could, but without any result
