3. Appointment of meeting secretary

Anna Rosa (ITA) is appointed as meeting secretary.

4. Approval of the minutes of 2021 autumn meeting

The minutes of the last meeting are approved.

5. Preparations for FIS Roller Ski WC 2022

1st stage Bø, Telemark (NOR)

Tormod Hynne from Telemark OC introduces 1st World Cup stage. LOC they has experience from previous years with TelemarkVeka event organization. All competitions will be broadcasted in national TV as well as online on Youtube. Norwegian national teams are expected to take part. Total prize money will exceed EUR 21.000. Official invitation already sent to the NSAs.

2nd stage Otepää/Tartu (EST)

Ave Nurk from LOC explains that preparation is going on following the original plan. There are some options for 20.08. Mass start course location change.

3rd stage Madona (LAT)

LAT - Ludvig Remb proposes to move WC Madona stage to 11-14.08. because of school and Alliansloppet at the same time, that will reduce Swedish participation, but Martins Niklass explains that he discuss this late proposal with LOC. Moving stage 2 weeks earlier make difficulties to LOC. Also 11-14.08. would overlap FIS Junior camp in Norway, which would impact participation of JUN athletes.

4th stage TBC (ITA)

ITA - Anna Rosa explains that FISU would like to host the event in a new location that the FIS WC coordinator has visited in 2021. There will be a FISU official inspection next week and that after that more info will be available. Martins Niklass asks to get the form before May 18th (CCC).

Martins Niklass informs that a potential candidate is Trondheim / Trondelag (NOR)

6.4 New rule on tips protection

From 01th July ICR 396.2.6 update enter into force (Cross-Country ski poles must be used with Cross-Country skiing tips must be used. **Alternatively poles tips must have safety rigid plastic protections with diameter ≥ 30 mm. These protections must be placed maximum 45 mm above the metallic tips.**

Application of this article will not be compulsory during 1st WC stage (24-26 June). Ludvig Remb explains that he sees potential problems of enforcing this article during this summer because market has not reacted properly with new offer of pole basket/tips. Martins Niklass explains there are producers on market (for ex. ITA) which offer adjustable (removable) protections for existing rollerski poles tips which meets 396.2.6. requirements. Pierre Mignerey adds that Swix and OneWay have asked for approval of their new pole baskets/tips.

6.5 FIS Passport update

Pierre Mignerey says that FIS passport application during 2022 summer events is not defined yet.
