Junior World Championships 21/22, Park & Pipe, Leysin (SUI)

Martijn Oostdijk presented the successful Junior Worlds briefly. Date 6th to 13th Mars 2022.

Junior World Championships 21/22, Moguls and Aerials, Chiesa in Valmalenco (ITA)

Tina Tanaka Sundequist presented the Junior Worlds briefly which took place from 25th to 28th March 2022, Mogul, Dual Mogus, Dual Mogul Team and Aerial and Aerial Team events. The HJ and one scoring judge were in place, rest of the scoring judges worked remotely.

Junior World Championships 21/22, SB Alpine, Chiesa in Valmalenco (ITA)

31st March to 2nd April, PGS, PSL, Parallel Team events were organised.

- Women 45, Men 47, Total 16 nations
- JPN, KOR, SUI, POL, GER, AUT, CZE, GER, USA, ITA, CAN, UKR, NED, HUN, GBR, BUL

Junior World Championships 21/22 Cross in Veysonnaz (SUI)

Susanne Borth presented the Junior Worlds briefly which took place from "Switzerland stepped in at very short notice with the Cross World Cup station Veysonnaz. Unfortunately, the team competitions could not be organised in such a short time and therefore had to be cancelled. Despite the capricious weather, the competitions in ski cross and snowboard cross could be held.

European Youth Olympic Festival 2022, Snowboard SS/BA, Vuokatti (FIN)

20th March to 25th March. Extremely successful snowboard Slopestyle and snowboard Big Air competitions were held on top facilities during a springlike week in Vuokatti, Finland. The two OC managers Marita Kaipainen and Simo Suopamki reviewed the EYOF with some final information.

8. Rule Proposals

The coaches discussed the competition format in the Snowboard Big Air at the EYOF 2022 and wondered if the qualification could be done differently. The judging format for qualification was: two jumps best jump count, whereby the direction of rotation was not taken into account. For the finals the judging format was: three jumps and the best two different jumps count. The final then showed that many riders only knew one direction of rotation and the level of riding was correspondingly low and many riders bailed.

The coaches' question is: Wouldn't it be better if the riders had to show three jumps with different rotation directions already in the qualification? The coaches' opinion is that the basics should be worked on and evaluated in young talents competitions. This should also be reflected in the international youth competition format.

Ola Sundeqvist from the Judges Advisory Group explained that there are different formats to choose from in the Judges Handbook for Snowboard & Freeski. However, the format for international youth events can always be applied at an early stage with the FIS and the respective organising committee and TD. To address a rule change proposal is therefore not necessary.

9. FIS <>WSF Grassroots

There are two World Snowboarding Federations. The WSF (successor of the ISF and the TTR) and FIS. WSF as the worldwide ultimate authority for grassroots and youth competitive Snowboarding and FIS as the global promotor of competitive snowboarding. A written agreement for the cooperation is in place and a working group was set up last December 2022. An update of the ideas and visions that have emerged was presented. The athlete pathway (FTEM framework) was consulted to better see development potential for grassroots work and transitions into elite snowboarding. The presentation was made by the Chair together with WSF Vice President Dominic Kuhn and the WSF Judge Education Coordinator Tom Wagener.
