3. Appointment of a Secretary

Harald Haim and Martin Künzle were willing to be the secretaries of this meeting.

4. Approval of the Agenda and Additions to it

The agenda was sent out to all members and was unanimously accepted.



5. Approval of the Minutes of the last Meeting,

The minutes were unanimously approved.

6. Reports, opinions, and stories 2023-2024

A presentation of Berni Schödler, FIS Coordinator COC was shown and discussed.

- FIS Youth competitions

It was not possible to get organizers for the traditional competitions like Youth Cup and Children Grand Prix in Ski Jumping. The "New Star Trophy" was used as the format for three competitions in Rasnov/ROU, Bad Freienwalde/GER (Summer) and Val di Fiemme/ITA (Winter). In Nordic Combined the cooperation and responsibility under the NSA's seems to be better as the Youth Cups in Oberwiesenthal/GER (Summer) and Harrachov/CZE (Winter) were organized and have been very well attended.

- FIS Cup

Roughly the same numbers in participating athletes and nations as we saw in the last years. The only critical point is the missing of one competition of the FIS Cup in one of the periods of the winter season.

- JWSC Planica (SLO)
 Better numbers (participants, nations, teams) compared to the JWSC in Whistler/CAN in 2023.
- Other important reports or items from 2023-2024
 In women ski jumping we had the reduction of the "old" system with WC, COC and FIS Cup to the new system with WC and ICOC. This led to no significant changes in the participation of the competitions

7. Future Youth Competitions 2024-25

JWSC 2025: negociations with Lake Placid/USA look good but are not confirmed yet. Date would be likely the $10^{th} - 16^{th}$ of February 2025.

EYOF 2025 in Bakuriani/GEO: there will be no Skijumping and no Nordic Combined as there is no jumping hill available.

The German Ski Federation pointed out, that it is not possible to organize "Youth Cup" and "Children Grand Prix" without the support of FIS (which was provided in the past).

8. Ski Jumping Rules - Suggestions to Jumping Committee

- New equipment rules will be in place only in Summer Grand Prix and COC. In lower levels they will be implemented for the winter season.
- There will be a suggestion for a new quota system for junior athletes in World Cup. Details will be presented in Portoroz.

There are no suggestions to the Jumping Committee from our SC.

9. Other items arising

Discussion about the best support for young women in the development to a World Cup athlete. It is about the right steps (hill size, competitions) in accordance to the age and the performance level of the athletes. The nations seem to face the same problems in their systems. Once more it is announced that the FESA Alpen Cup for women I open to all nations.

Renata Nadarkiewicz (POL) and Sepp Buchner (GER) were attending their last meeting in the SC and chairman and members thanked them for their contributions.
