3. Approval of the agenda

The proposed agenda was approved without amendments.

4. Approval of the minutes of the meeting held in Zurich, on 26th September 2025
The minutes of the previous meeting held in Zurich were approved.

5. Information about the season 2024/25 (Inputs from all Members)

FIS UNI Races incl FIS pt 2024 25.pdf

Despite limited snow in some regions, the season was successful overall.

- A total of 105 races were held; only 11 were cancelled.
- 41 FIS-UNI races calculated with the minimum penalty (23.00 Pt), most in USA.
- 69 races were hosted in the USA, 8 in JPN and 28 Europe (POL/SVK/CZE/ITA/SUI)
- 7 National Ski Associations (NSAs) hosted races. High-level performance was observed across the board. Good average of participation on most of the FIS-UNI races.
- Continental Cup level at Winter University Games (WUG) 2025 Torino/Bardonecchia (ITA) with a record of participants from 44 NSA's in alpine skiing
- Appreciation was expressed to all organisers, officials, and coaches.

Reports from NSAs:

- USA (DL): 145 institutions, strong Alpine Skiing presence, 18–26-year-olds, self-funded, international athletes present. High level wit minimum penalty (23.00) in 60% of all races. USSS Collegiate Working Group - USCSA 2025 Report.pdf



- Japan (HS): Heavy snow caused cancellations, stable participation around 100-120 each competition.
- Poland (GW): High regional participation, good conditions in December, cancelation due to less snow in spring. Exchange between POL / SVK / CZE is aimed by athletes The chair spokes collective thanks extended to all supporting FIS UNI races.

6. Report FISU World University Winter Games Turin 2025

8. Discussion about future composition and status FIS-UNI Committee (2026 ff)

- Discussion on new Terms of Reference for all FIS Committees.
- Key goals: supervision, proposals, collaboration for all questions to support
- Gender Balance was discussed (30-40% women)
- Possible reduction in committee size; maintain NSA representation during the last years in this committee. All NSA with FIS-UNI races and support for student sports in general are preferred for representation on the FIS-UNI committee. Actual situation (draft) for committee 2026-28: USA / JPN / ITA / POL / SVK / CZE / SUI and due to long presence AUT / GER / CAN / FRA / SLO. Still an open question for 2026-2028 and next meeting.
- IRI stressed the University Federation's role. Special situation for small nations.

9. Miscellaneous / Questions

- JPN: Airbag usage for speed disciplines not mandatory at FIS-UNI level, cost considerations. But probably for next WUG'27.
- Promotion of IOC-FIS WISH programme for women in high-performance sport.

Scheduled for 23–27 September 2025, Zurich (SUI).
